Jan-Erik Siewert from the group of Christian Hering-Junghans wins poster prize at virtual poster event of the *Canadian Institute of Chemistry (CIC)* via Twitter

Alternatives are in demand:

Last week, the *Canadian Institute of Chemistry (CIC)* hosted a 48-hour poster event on Twitter, attended by 166 scientists from over 20 nations around the globe.

Jan-Erik Siewert, Master student in the junior research group "Activation of Small Molecules" of Christian Hering-Junghans, also participated in the *GIDW (Global Inorganic Discussion Weekdays)* poster event with his work from his methodological and research internship.

The posters were published in the form of a Twitter post with the hashtag #gidw2020. Afterwards, interested parties had the opportunity to ask questions via the commentary function, which led to a lively exchange and discussion.

50 jurors evaluated the high quality posters. A total of 30 prizes were awarded, which were sponsored by *Dalton Transactions*, *Sir Jeffrey Wilkinson Trust Fund*, *de Gruyter Publishing* and the *Inorganic Division of the CIC*, among others.

Jan-Erik Siewert's contribution, "Terphenyl(bisamino)phosphines as Ligands in Gold Catalysis", was awarded the prize of the Inorganic Division of the CIC.
